A Little Advice from Nurse Dora THE IMPORTANCE **OF SOCIAL MINISTRY CONNECTIONS**

Friendships become more important as we age, yet social connections for seniors can be more difficult to create and maintain. Many older adults find it difficult to make new friends after retirement, which can lead to feelings of loneliness and social isolation. It's not because seniors lack the social skills to make and maintain new friendships, rather they don't have access to regular opportunities or social engagement with their peers.

Studies show social isolation is associated with decreased cognitive function and increased symptoms of anxiety and depression. Social activities and events for seniors that promote autonomy, support mastering a familiar or new subject, and enhance friendships between others are especially likely to improve well-being the of those who Alona with improvina participate. symptoms of anxiety and depression and increasing cognitive function, healthy social connections may promote more self -confidence, better sleep and enhanced mood. Studies also show strong social connections significantly reduce the rate of cognitive decline and dementia while also having positive physical effects on the body such as improving cardiovascular health. Overall, staying socially active can create a positive impact on both our mental and physical health as we age.
