

A Little Advice from Nurse Dora PROTECT YOURSELF FROM THE SUMMER SUN

When the sun is out it is crucial to take preventative measures to protect your skin and eyes from UV radiation. This includes

wearing sunscreen, protective clothing, sunglasses and seeking shade, especially during peak sun hours.

- Use a broad-spectrum sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher. Apply generously to all exposed skin and reapply every two hours.
- Wear long-sleeved shirts, long pants, and wide-brimmed hats to shield your skin from the sun's rays.
- Opt for sunglasses that block 100% of UV radiation, and have wrap-around frames to protect your eyes.
- Find a shaded area whenever possible, especially during peak sun hours, between 10am and 4pm.
- Check your skin for any new mole or changes in existing ones, and see a dermatologist for regular skin cancer screenings.
- Drink plenty of water to stay hydrated, especially during prolonged sun exposure.
- Be mindful of sunburn since sunburn can significantly increase the risk of skin cancer.

Skin cancer is by far the most common cancer with there being three main forms. The most common type is basal cell carcinoma which usually looks like an elevated transparent bump on the skin.

Squamous cell carcinoma is the second most common type of skin cancer. This often resembles a red bump that may manifest as a sore or wound that heals and then opens up again.

Melanoma is the third type, and the one that causes the majority of deaths from skin cancer. Melanoma can develop within a mole that already exists or as a new dark spot on the skin. Melanoma is usually asymmetrical with irregular edges, multiple colors or shades and is usually larger than the diameter of a pencil eraser. Anyone who notices these features of a mole should get it checked out as soon as possible by a doctor.
